
Mont St. Clair pastry shop is the creation of second generation patissier, Hironobu Tsujiguchi located in Tokyo's Jiyugaoka.


As one of the pioneer oriental health spas in Asia, it reintroduced an exotic blend of ancient health and beauty practices which have been passed down from generation to generation.

Trained gym instructors are on hand to guide you through a range of activities that include aerobics, yoga, cardio, stretches, resistance training and rock wall climbing.






Namdaemun Market

Gwanghwamun Square is a historic plaza featuring statues of King Sejong and Admiral Yi Sun-sin.


Nearby, Cheonggyecheon Stream offers a tranquil escape with scenic walking paths and seasonal light displays.

The War Memorial of Korea is an extensive museum showcasing Korea's military history, including exhibits from the Korean War.


It features outdoor displays of tanks, aircraft, and other military equipment.
